There are now several systems on offer, including, wet, dry, and retrofit/overlay, we believe it is possible to find a system to suit most budgets. Once you have made the initial investment, you can take advantage of the benefits of underfloor heating being up to 25% more efficient than traditional radiators for many years to come.


The Cost of underfloor heating

The exact figure will always depend on the system you choose, how big an area you want to heat, how many different zones you require and so on. The only way to know for sure is to get in touch for your free quotation. A typical kit for a 20m² room will cost from as little as **£399.99**

UFH can even be fitted to your current boiler and used as the primary source of heat in a home or a combination of UFH and radiators. A heat loss study of your home is always recommended to calculate your requirements. In the absence of this, assumptions can be made.

In some existing properties, you may need to have the sub-floor removed and reinstated at a lower level, to allow for insulation typically 75mm and 50mm of liquid screed.

Alternatively, we offer a retrofit/overlay underfloor heating system supplied from as little as £50.00m² giving an install depth of 18mm ready to receive floor finishes.

Cost benefits of underfloor heating

The cost benefits of underfloor heating do not end once it is installed. It will continue to offer value for money in several ways:

Running costs – Underfloor heating works on radiant heat which is more energy-efficient than convection heating. Over time, the initial cost will be offset by the savings on heating bills. Using a wet system, the water circulating under the floor can heat the room using a much lower temperature than conventional heating and therefore requires less energy to heat the space. This translates to lower energy bills.

Depending on the source of energy being used to run the system, a wet underfloor heating system can cost up to 25% less to run than a traditional radiator system.

Long-term investment – There is no doubt that underfloor heating represents a long-term investment in your property and can even add value to your property. If fitted with sub-floor insulation, as well as a high standard of insulation throughout. This will increase the Energy Performance rating of the property. This certifies how efficient the home is, which can be attractive to potential buyers, especially if they are deciding between yours and similar properties.

Low maintenance - If installed correctly, there is extraordinarily little that can go wrong with underfloor heating over its lifetime. This means no annual servicing, no bleeding the system because air has become trapped inside, no changing of rusty radiators and so on. A few system checks now and again are all that is required.
